

Oregon Junior Dance Team Championship!

Oregon's Junior Dance Team Championship is excited about this event and hope that you will be able to join us for the fun!

- What:** Junior Dance Team Championship. Recognizing Oregon's dance talent!
- Who:** May be a private or public dance team. 1st grade through 8th grade for "junior teams", up to 12th for "club high school teams" and 9th-11th for "Public J.V. teams".
- When:** Saturday, April 3th, 2010
- Where:** Clackamas Community College
- Divisions:** Will be set upon receipt of entries. We are anticipating the following divisions:
Mini division (school or private) not to exceed 3rd grade
jazz or hip-hop
Youth division (school or private) not to exceed 6th grade
jazz or hip-hop
Junior School division-not to exceed 8th grade
dance: any style applies.
Junior Club division-not to exceed 8th grade
jazz, lyrical or hip-hop
Junior Varsity - School Division not to exceed 11th grade
dance: any style applies
Senior Club division - not to exceed 12th grade
jazz, lyrical or hip-hop
- Rounds:** **Each team will perform once only.** There will be a morning round and an evening round. Upon receiving entries the rounds will be set.
- Placing:** 50% of the teams entered in a division will determine the amount of trophies given out, not to exceed 5 places. Example: 8 teams are entered in a division. 50% of 8 is 4. 4 places will be awarded.
- Entry:** There is no limit on the amount of teams your school or club may enter. **But, there are strict guidelines to entering the correct age bracket. A team will be disqualified for having an "over age" dancer in their group.**

Entry fee: \$100 per team and \$75 per additional entry for that specific team.
This will include the use of a room.

Deadline: February 12th, 2010.

Routine: Length of routine may be 2-3 minutes. The timing will begin with the first beat of music or the first step onto the floor, which ever is first. This includes entrance and exit onto the floor.

Sets: No sets are allowed

Props: One prop per dancer allowed. A prop is a fan, umbrella, pom-pom, chair, etc.

Costume Change: None allowed for during a routine.

Drill Down: There will be three drill downs; elementary, junior and high school. Ten ribbons will be awarded in each division. All drill-down participants must be in full costume to compete.

Please check which division(s) your team will be competing in:

- Mini Division (school or private) – jazz (not to exceed 3rd grade)
- Mini Division (school or private) – hip hop (not to exceed 3rd grade)
- Youth Division (school or private) – jazz (not to exceed 6th grade)
- Youth Division (school or private) – hip hop (not to exceed 6th grade)
- Junior School Division * – dance (not to exceed 8th grade)
- Junior Club Division – jazz (not to exceed 8th grade)
- Junior Club Division – lyrical (not to exceed 8th grade)
- Junior Club Division – hip hop (not to exceed 8th grade)
- Junior Varsity School Division* – dance (not to exceed 11th grade)
- Senior Club Division – jazz (not to exceed 12th grade)
- Senior Club Division – lyrical (not to exceed 12th grade)
- Senior Club Division – hip hop (not to exceed 12th grade)

* = Teams entered in the public school divisions who wish to enter a second or third routine may do so by entering each additional routine in the appropriate *club* division.

Example: The Dancing Daisies have two routines; a Jazz and a Hip Hop. They may enter their jazz routine in the Junior School Division and their Hip Hop in the Junior Club - Hip Hop Division.
